

# Don't Iron, Press! Master Seams Like a Pro - Ultimate Cheat Sheet

- **Knits & Stretch Fabrics:** Use a cool iron and gentle pressure to avoid distorting knit fabrics. Test on a scrap first to ensure no melting.

## Tool Time:

- **Iron:** Choose an iron with adjustable heat settings and a smooth soleplate. A steam function can be helpful for stubborn wrinkles.
- **Pressing Cloth:** A lightweight fabric like cotton or muslin protects delicate fabrics from direct heat and helps distribute the press evenly.
- **Tailor's Ham:** This curved ham-shaped tool is ideal for pressing curved seams and darts.

## Bonus Boost:

- **Press as you sew:** Iron seams flat as you sew each section, rather than waiting until

the garment is complete. This saves time and ensures optimal seam quality.

- **Spritz strategically:** A light mist of water can help activate the fabric's memory and create crisp creases, especially in cotton fabrics.
- **Let it cool:** Allow your pressed seams and darts to cool completely before handling to prevent them from shifting or relaxing. ✨
